



Midnight Rally – Paved TSD

This stand alone paved, moderately challenging TSD event is the last one for 2006 organized by the Island RallySport Club and sanctioned by RPM & CARS. It will be running under their Rally Regulations, and will be starting and ending in Duncan. This novice difficulty event is perfect for those wanting to learn about rallying, since it is conducted on pavement only. With speeds regulated to be below the speed limits posted, it is safe and fun for everyone. All road legal cars are eligible to be entered. There will be 2 classes Novice and Expert, the same as in our short Novice Series earlier this year. This way, if this is your first time, you're not competing against experienced teams. But in fact, that doesn't matter all that much, because it is the fun of running, and meeting and talking to all the other entrants and workers, discussing silly mistakes you made in following the instructions that will stick in your mind more than anything else.

This all pavement rally is approximately 165 km long, and will take you along only paved roads between Duncan and Cedar (near Nanaimo). The route will be somewhat challenging due to calculations and driving conditions, which could be wet, but will definitely be dark. All vehicles entered must be in good working order. The car must be owned by one of the two team members or you must have written permission from the owner for it to be used in the rally.
