Supplementary Regulations

Pacific Coast Challenge - B.C. TSD Rally Championship - Island Rally Series

The Rally

This year, IRC's PCC entry will be Crestline Trail held in the BC interior. As is tradition, our PCC rally will also be a round of the BC TSD Rally Championship, and part of the Island Rally Series. It will be a "brisk" TSD rally covering about 1000 km of south central BC roads using straightforward instructions, within the Kootenays.

The Route

The rally is going to head east from Osoyoos on Saturday morning, to overnight in the West Kootenays, BC, with a return to Osoyoos on Sunday. The roads are expected to be approximately 10% paved (mostly transits), and 90% gravel (mostly regularities).

The Regulations

The rally follows the BC TSD Rally Regulations as well as the CARS General Competition Rules, which can be obtained by contacting the IRC Rally Director Glyn Trafford at gtrafford@shaw.ca or (250) 246-8282. We may be 'pushing the envelope' when it comes to gas stops, so don't bring that gas guzzler.

The Rules

Competitors will be given a route book approximately 30 minutes prior to the departure time of the first car, at the Drivers Meeting. The route book will have distances and speeds in both imperial and metric units. Distances will be based on metric units measured to thousandths of a km, then converted to imperial units.

For BC TSD Championship events the following classes and definitions shall be used

i/ Unlimited

ii/ Calculator: Non-programmable calculating devices which are not driven by a wheel, and accessory odometers.

iii/ Paper: No calculators, rally tables or accessory odometers

iv/ Novice: Neither team member having entered more than 3 TSD rallies before the current year, and equipment limited to Calculator Class.

v/ Historic: Vehicles manufactured more than 25 years prior to December 31 of the year preceding the current competition season. Navigational equipment is Unlimited.

For the purpose of the Pacific Coast Challenge (PCC) and Island Rally Series (IRS) points; Unlimited will be classed as Unlimited; Calculator will be classed as Equipped; Paper will be classed as SOP. Historic and Novice entries are to declare the PCC or IRS class in which they wish to run, based on the navigation equipment being used, as defined above in the BC Championship classes.

The membership of IRC feels that rallying is more than just an entertainment to be simply paid for, and as such has passed a requirement that in order to compete in an IRC rally, an individual must be a full & paid up member of a recognized North American rally club. Proof must be presented in the form of a current membership card, or written declaration by the President of the member's club. Clubs will be permitted to sign up new members at registration.

The Rooms

For the night of June 20 (Friday), the only time we have registration, so that rally can start early on Saturday morning, there has been an arrangement made for a block of rooms at a reduced rate, under "Crestline Rally" in the Best Western Sunrise Inn 5506 Main Street RR 6, Osoyoos, BC V0H 1V6 Canada (877) 878-2200 www.bestwesternosoyoos.com The Sunrise Inn includes a continental breakfast.

Please, make your own arrangements in Osoyoos or environs; due to team sporting events, space is limited. 1st come, 1st served.

For the night of June 21 (Saturday), and since the rally is at the start of tourist season and overnights in an area with limited amenities, accommodation and dinner on Saturday night will be included in your registration.

You MUST let the Registrar know if your team can share a Queen or King bed or if you need two separate beds. You must also let the Registrar know of any special food concerns or requirements.

It will need to be hard copy mailed to the Registrar, and documentation will be checked at Registration on Friday, June 20th. Be SURE you have your club membership card as proof.

In order to guarantee entry, and accommodation, your timely paid entry is required to be received no later than June 6 2008, 14 days before the rally. A minimum of 15 entries must be in our hands at this cutoff date, or the rally will be cancelled. You can make private accommodation arrangements if you wish, and MUST if you are past the June 6th cutoff, however there will be NO reduction in the registration fee in these scenarios. Entries will be limited to 40; any received beyond that number will be retained, in received order, to substitute for another team which pulls out before the rally.

Also, please use the pdf copy of the Technical Inspection form to ensure your car and you are ready to rally. Bring it with you to registration and Tech, at Lordco, 10 Eagle Court RR 2 Osoyoos, BC, with your personal and automotive details.
