

Round 4 of the 2005 Island Novice Rally Series

August 14, 2005

This paved Time Speed Distance rally takes place in the North Coastal area of Vancouver Island. It is the final round of the 4 round Island Novice Rally Series for 2005, organized by the Island Rallysport Club, which is affiliated with Rally Pacific Motorsports, and the Canadian Association of Rallysport (CARS). This Novice Rally Series follows the 2004 BC TSD Rally Regulations as well as the CARS General Competition Rules. Teams consist of two people, and the driver is required to hold a valid Provincial Driver's License or equivalent and the driver, navigator and passengers not of the age of majority in British Columbia shall have written permission of parents or guardian to participate in the event. It is **recommended** that teams have a Calculator, Pen, Highlighter and Clipboard, as well as a sense of adventure and enthusiasm.

The vehicle must be owned by one of the team members or they must have written permission from the registered owner(s) for its use in the rally.

Rally details

The rally, which will be approximately 155 km long, will be on choice paved roads near Campbell River, Black Creek, Merville and Comox. There will be two legs, with a midpoint 20 minute break at Miracle Beach. Each Leg will consist of three Regularities, which are timed sections in which hidden checkpoints will record your arrival time; and transits, which are untimed sections.

Timing is done by drive-by control positions. Checkpoint crews record your time as you pass by. Controls will not be placed within 200 metres of the beginning or end of a regularity, Stop or Yield signs, or any instruction causing competitors to stop or pause.

Due to interest in this event from a wide spectrum of novices, instructions and average speeds will be listed in kilometers as well as miles.

Scoring is done by perfect time with 1 penalty point per second late or early. Your goal is to accurately follow the average speeds instructed in order to achieve the lowest possible score. The speeds will always be below the posted speed limit, and transit sections will allow ample time to reach the next regularity without exceeding the speed limit. The maximum penalty for any given checkpoint is 300 points (5 minutes), to a maximum of 600 points over any single regularity.

Any competitor who is issued a traffic violation citation while participating in this event will be subject to disqualification.

Classes are:

Novice – Just as it sounds, newcomers not having competed in more than 3 rallies.

Experienced – Any rallyist who has competed in more than 3 rallies.

Awards will be presented to the Novice Class winners.

Early registration will guarantee you a space in the event. You can register just before the event, but the maximum number of entries accepted will be 25 on a first come, first serve basis.

Directions to Rally Start:

Heading North from Nanaimo – Take the Inland Highway (Hwy. 19), to 14th Avenue and then turn right. 14th Ave. becomes 9th Avenue. From 9th Ave. turn left onto Ironwood Street. Turn right at first TS onto 13th Avenue. Ricky's is about one block down on your right.

Heading South from Sayward/Port Hardy – Take Hwy. 19 south to 14th Avenue and then turn left. 14th Ave. becomes 9th Avenue. From 9th, turn left onto Ironwood Street. Turn right at first TS onto 13th Avenue. Ricky's is about one block down on your right.

This Rally Series has four events in total:

- 1. Novice #1 was held in Victoria on March 20, 2005.
- 2. Novice #2 was held in the Nanaimo area on April 10, 2005.
- 3. Novice #3 was held in Oceanside (Parksville area) on June 5th, 2005.
