



## **Saunders Subaru Island Novice TSD Rally Series - #4**

This is the final round of the 3 part 2006 Island Novice Rally Series (#3 was cancelled), sponsored by Saunders Subaru, organized by Island RallySport Club and sanctioned by RPM & CARS: running under their Rally Regulations, will be starting and ending in Duncan. Novice events are perfect for those wanting to learn about rallying, since they are conducted on pavement only. With speeds regulated to be below the speed limits posted, they are safe and fun for everyone. All road legal cars are eligible to be entered. There are two classes, Novice and Expert. This way, if this is your first time, you're not competing against experienced teams. But in fact, that doesn't matter all that much, because it is the fun of running, and meeting and talking to all the other entrants and workers, discussing mistakes you made in following the instructions that will stick in your mind more than anything else.

This all pavement rally is approximately 170 km long, and will take you along only paved roads between Duncan and Cedar (near Nanaimo). The route will be somewhat challenging but very scenic. All vehicles entered must be in good working order. The car must be owned by one of the two team members or you must have written permission from the owner for it to be used in the rally.
