SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Organized by Island RallySport Club

Sanctioned by RPM & CARS

These are Supplementary Regulations for the finale of the 2006 Zensport Edge of the Rock Rally Cross series organized by Island Rallysport Club. The event is to be held on September 23/24 at the lower parking lot of Mount Washington Alpine Resort. Although it is a two day event, each day will have separate results. Competitors may enter both days or only one.

Saturday Sept 23 Registration/Tech 9:00am to 10:00am Parking lot

Walk the course 10:00am
First run 10:15am

Final run TBA then to Fat Teddy's

Sunday Sept 24 Car preparation 8:30am to 9:00am Parking lot

Walk the course 9:00am
First run 9:15am
Final run 3:00pm

Rally Cross is a timed rally-based motorsport competition designed to test the skill and consistency of the driver on a gravel slalom course. All runs count towards the total time for each day which is determined by adding up the times for each run. For regulations, refer to CARS National Rallysprint Regulations 1.0 Rally Cross at www.carsrally.ca.

IMPORTANT: Mount Washington Alpine Resort has allowed Island Rallysport Club the use of its gravel facility if competitors and workers of this Rally Cross stay overnight at official resort accommodations. Please book your overnight stay at Deer Lodge through the resort as early as possible. Mention "Island Rallysport Club" to get the Rally Cross rate \$119 + taxes for a one bedroom. Larger suites are available upon request. Please do not book your accommodation elsewhere. IRC wants to be able to come back for Rally Cross at this site in 2007!

<u>Course</u> - Red cones and banner tape will define courses each of which will be run a minimum of three times and which are designed to test a driver's skill. There will be one competitor vehicle on course at a time, a countdown start, a flying finish and a

stop control. Course marshals will have flags, fire extinguishers and radios; and will be in contact with Rally Control at all times. St. John Ambulance will provide First Aid service. Nearest hospital is 33 km away in Comox via paved public road.

<u>Vehicles</u> - All street legal closed body vehicles in good working order are eligible for entry. The driver must own the vehicle or written permission from the owner must be presented for use of the vehicle in this event (space on entry form or letter). One passenger may be carried. No person under 16 years of age is allowed in a competing vehicle.

<u>Mandatory Safety Equipment</u> - Each person in a competing vehicle must wear a SNELL or equivalent rated SA90, M90 or newer helmet. Minimum three point seat harnesses must be worn by driver and passenger. All loose objects must be removed prior to going on course.

<u>Entry Requirement</u> - Legally licensed drivers are eligible to compete. Minors 16 to 19 years of age require written permission signed by parent or guardian. Competitors require, at minimum, a Basic CARS performance license (issued by RPM and available on site for \$10 per event or \$25 for the year); and a membership in a CARS affiliated club. Island Rallysport Club will be offering an event membership for \$10 at registration. A passenger must sign a waiver but does not require a CARS licence or club membership.

**Entry Fee** - \$100 for the two days; \$60 for one day (either of Saturday or Sunday\*).

\*Note: There will be no registration or tech on Sunday morning. Persons wishing to compete on Sunday only will require special arrangements with Organizer Paul Smith if not available to undertake registration and tech on Saturday morning.

<u>PRE-REGISTRATION and PAYMENT</u> are required for this event. Please send a completed entry form and payment (cheques payable to Island Rallysport Club) to be received by the Registrar before September 20:

<u>Potential for Cancellation:</u> Should there not be enough paid entrants or volunteer workers by 3:00pm September 20, 2006, Rally Cross #5/6 will be cancelled. The minimum number of paid entrants is fifteen (15). A minimum of 12 workers is required each day to run safely and efficiently. If the event is cancelled, paid entrants will be immediately advised at the e-mail address on entry form and entry monies returned.

Four Classes – Rally: 2 wheel drive and 4 wheel drive; Street: 2 wheel drive and 4 wheel drive.

<u>Awards</u> – Points will be awarded for finish position each day. The points will count towards the 2006 Zensport Edge of the Rock Rally Cross Series Championship. Winners are to receive recognition for their 2006 Rally Cross achievements at Island Rallysport Club's annual awards function November 25, 2006.
